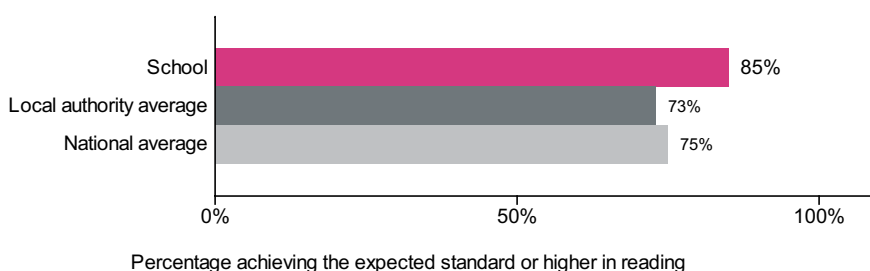

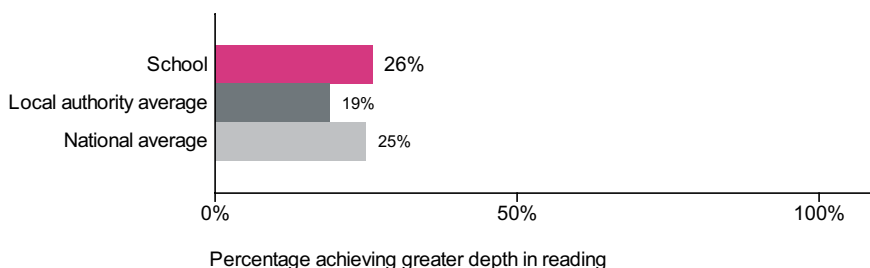
Percentage achieving the expected standard or higher in reading

Number of pupils = 46



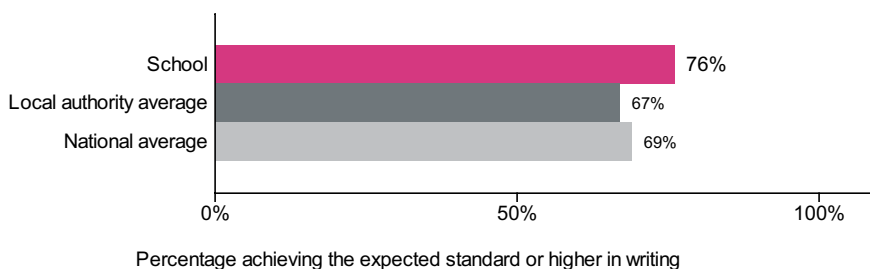
Percentage achieving greater depth in reading

Number of pupils = 46



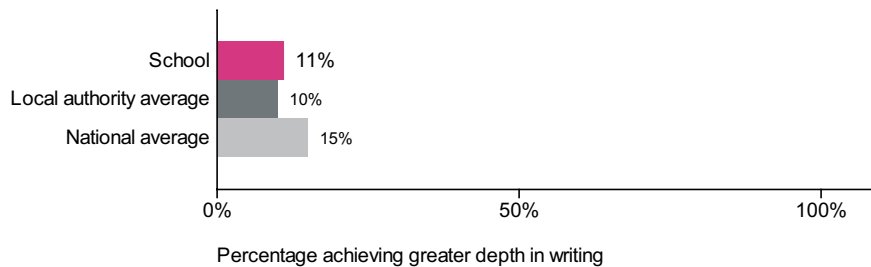
Percentage achieving the expected standard or higher in writing

Number of pupils = 46



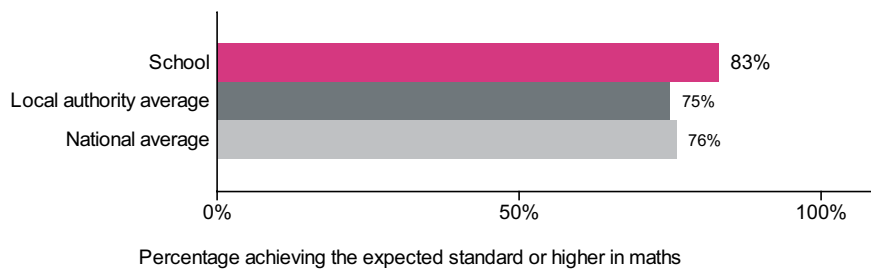
Percentage achieving greater depth in writing
